Now That I Am a Christian

Sometimes the question is posed, "Now that I am a Christian, what now?" There is a word for those of us who have been converted. God has not left us void of instructions concerning our responsibility after conversion. The Bible is replete with verses that declare that our obligation is to CONTINUE. On the first Pentecost after the resurrection, Luke, the inspired historian, informs us that they CONTINUED steadfastly in the apostles doctrine (Acts 2:42). This is affirmed by the Christ during His personal ministry whereas He clearly stated, "If you CONTINUE in my word then are ye my disciples indeed" (John 8:31).
