- ☛ At the third stop sign, turn right. (This is Sells Ave. and the ramp to I-20 East).
- ☛ Take I-20 east to Exit 56A - McDaniel Street.
- ☛ Turn right at first light onto McDaniel Street.
- ☛ Turn left at second light onto Ralph D. Abernathy Blvd.
- ☛ Turn right at fifth light onto Pollard Boulevard.
- ☛ Go to third block and turn left into AWDA parking lot.
