Prepare To Meet Your God

**W**e are grateful for the wonderful revival that has taken place this week. It is my prayer that you received with meekness, the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. Now that you have received the word, it is time to apply it. What good is the word if there is no application?

This morning we want to visit some powerful truths concerning our inevitable meeting with God. While we do not know when, the bible teaches that there will be a conclusion to life's story. Whatever your story may be, know that there will be a conclusion. It is my job as God's messenger to help you prepare for that conclusion. So many people are walking aimlessly through life without regard for the day we must stand before God. However, I want to suggest to all of us here today that the day is steadily approaching.
