Have You Been Washed

It is my prayer that you have been thoroughly blessed by this series thus far. The Tabernacle is an exciting study as we watch God teach Israel his plan to save man through shadows and symbols designed to point to Our Blessed Redeemer, Jesus Christ. Today, we have arrived at the Laver, which is the place where the priest was instructed to wash before he could enter into the Holy Place. All of us that are members of the church remember that we were in need of being washed.

We could never be members of God's holy church unless we had been washed. This washing was not one of removing our physical dirt, but our spiritual dirt. It would be honesty on our part to admit that as clean as we may be physically, we were a dirty people inwardly. If the truth be told, even after we are made clean, we often get dirty again. However, God has revealed through The Tabernacle that He has made cleansing available to mankind so that we can enter into His presence.

Today, we want to specifically focus on the washing of the alien sinner, while tonight we shall focus on the continual cleansing of the saint. Most religious organizations recognize a need for cleansing from sinfulness, but there is vast disagreement concerning how this cleansing takes place.
