Satan Desires to Have You

The Sunday before last, we began a series of lessons entitled "Satan Desires to Have You". To introduce this subject, we did an expositional study of Luke 22:30-31 where Jesus declared to Peter that Satan desired to sift all the disciples like wheat. This verse in no uncertain terms teaches that the people of God are in conflict with a fallen angel who is called Satan. Each of us are faced with the task of dealing with satanic strategies designed to arrest our faith in God. He is an adversary that will not rest until he has accomplished his, which is to devour you.

He seeks to destroy your relationship with God, your marriage, and your life. At times, he even seeks to use you as an instrument against God's purpose. Therefore, The Apostle Paul states, "Neither give place to the devil" (Eph. 4:27). This text means that we ought not give him opportunity. We must be mindful of his methods and tactics. You cannot effectively combat an enemy unless you know something about his mode of operation.

In today's lesson, we will explore that fact that Satan has ministers who operate under the concept of deceit and trickery, and launch vicious attacks on God's word to distort its true meaning. To some, it may be surprising to know that many of Satan's ministers are members of the church, who are driven by selfish ambition. Come with me into the text, and let's learn more about Satan's tactics.
