# The Tabernacle

**W**e have reached the midpoint of the tabernacle series. It is hoped that you have been blessed by this study - leaving each Sunday with rich information concerning God's scheme of redemption, which is wrapped up in the person of Jesus Christ. Last Sunday, we covered the items of furniture in the holy place which were the seven golden candlesticks, the table of shewbread, and the altar of incense. The seven golden candlesticks represented the Christian light in a dark world. That light is Jesus Christ. Each individual person has been commissioned to reflect the light of our Lord and Savior. The light gives us access to the table, the shewbread, which represents fellowship. With fellowship comes the altar of incense, which represents prayer. Without the light, there is no fellowship. Without fellowship there is no prayer. All of these blessings are received when one enters into the holy place.

Today we will look at the veil of the temple, which separates the holy place from the most holy place. The veil, like all the items of furniture in the tabernacle, has tremendous significance to the Christian faith. The veil was a dividing line. On the other side of the veil were the Ark of the Covenant and the mercy seat. Inside of the Ark were Aaron's rod, manna, and the two tables of stone, which contained the law. The most holy place represented the place where God actually dwelled. It was this place that no one had access to except for the high priest once a year. The veil represented a barrier or a boundary line to which no one was allowed to cross.

The veil teaches that there is a limit to man's accessibility to God. The only way to gain access to the most holy place is that somebody must remove the veil. Without the removal of the veil, there is no access. Without the removal of the veil, one cannot come into the very throne of God. While the veil stands, man is hopeless. While the veil remains, man is alienated. Who shall remove the veil? Who shall grant us access? How shall we ever come to the very presence of God and have access to his throne? Come now, and let us get a Word from the King!
