Satan is After Your Faith

Faith is the means by which we establish a relationship with God. Unbelief is the means by which our relationship with God is severed. This is clearly taught in Luke 22:31-32 which states, "And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for thee that your faith fail not... "Notice that the satanic attack was aimed at causing Peter's faith to fail. If he could get to Peter's faith, then likewise he could sever him from Christ.

This is nothing new with the devil. He is always after the faith of God's people. Israel consistently entered into a state of unbelief, which caused God to be displeased. In the New Testament, the book of Hebrews is a warning concerning unbelief. It is through unbelief that the child of God departs from the living God (Hebrews 3:12). As we are faced with this biblical truth, it is necessary that we take the time to nurture our faith. The way faith is nurtured is by having a consistent diet of the Word of God. Without the word, there can be no faith. It was the apostle Paul who said, "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God".
