The Righteous Shall Be Blessed!

The righteous are those who do that which is right, and good according to God's word. As the wicked shall one day be punished for their transgressions, even so shall the righteous be blessed for their obedience, and loyalty to Jesus. It is not enough merely to say Lord, Lord. We must do what the Lord say. Following His commandments is the way to life, and happiness. Human's search for happiness is doomed to failure. The pleasure of sin is only for a short time. The reward of righteousness is everlasting life.

When we say that the righteous shall be blessed, we mean that he or she shall be considered worthy of God's grace. Listen to the word! "Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ." (2 Thes. 1:11,12) Observe that God counts us worthy when we work by faith. As the Lord Himself said to John, "They shall walk with Me in white for they are worthy." (Rev. 3:4)

When one suffers for doing right, they have the blessing of God. (1 Pet. 3:14) It is sad, and ashamed that when you try to lead people in the good, and right way, they turn against you to harm you. Christianity is not a religion of violence; it is a religion of compassion. A religion which seeks to injury people is not from God. A religion which seeks to harm its enemy is anti-God, anti-Christ, and fails to honor God. The righteous shall be blessed because they strive to help others, and not hurt others. "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven." (Matt. 5:10) God will handle those who seek to hurt His people. Listen to Him, "Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord." (Rom. 12:19)
