We must do all we can at home for our youth to succeed in school.

Romans 8:28 tells us that all things should work together for the good for those that love God. As the 2006-07 school year moves into the second month, it is very important that our West End youth are on a steady and deliberate path to academic success whether it is in elementary, middle, or high school – and that each family is “working together for the good” in achieving victory in overall grades.

West End Parents:

If you are a West End parent with school-aged children, take the time today or tonight to sit with your children and discuss in detail each class. Talk about homework assignments, their interactions – or lack thereof - with the teacher, grades earned on quizzes and tests already taken; and discuss whether they are specifically passing or failing or heading for failure. Since each West End home is an extension of the Lord’s church and the West End family as a whole, it is important that our homes are havens of peace and positive communications regarding success in school. By creating an atmosphere of cooperation and mutual understanding, being able to avoid tension surrounding school work is paramount. Take a moment to pray together about the school discussion BEFORE talking about school work to create an atmosphere of success during and after the talk. Be ready to hear both the good and the not-so-good from your children. Also remember that if there are multiple classes to be discussed, that there may be several things to discuss. Remain calm and do not blow up and start yelling. Write things down, set expectations, administer corrective actions and appropriate punishments, and look for specific outcomes as to what should result over time. Be ready to contact your child’s teachers proactively, remembering that you may need to talk to your child’s counselor should the teacher be a challenge to reach.

West End Youth:

First, do your work as assigned and don’t fall behind! Your parents are your advocates and want you to get good grades. If you are struggling in one or more classes, tell your parents (or whoever is in charge of you) NOW! Nothing will hurt you more than your parents being surprised with a poor progress report or report card after the first quarter of work. God expects each of you to do your best in school, and to be good citizens in each class. You are personally responsible to God and yourselves for your grades. Ask for help if there is something you don’t understand. Communicate your confusion, lack of understanding or falling behind to your teacher and your parents right away. Ask for extra help from teachers, your parents, and students that you know understand the work. If you are a disruption in the classroom and are a representative for your family, for Christ and for West End, you need to end those antics immediately. No teacher should be able to speak poorly of you and be right about it. Live such good lives so if anyone accuses you of doing wrong it won’t fit your long-term track record of good deeds and good conduct in the classroom (1 Peter 2:12).

Let’s not be fooled. Young people in our congregation fail classes, have behavior problems, and get suspended for a variety of reasons. Some (prayerfully most) will get good grades and have no issues at all. Whatever the cases, determine what it is in your home, address it, and make positive progress. Parents and children in West End’s families working together and being accountable will please the Lord, and make our congregation stronger.
