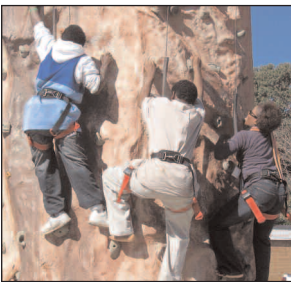


Update on New Sunday Service Times
